### **LM in Action: Updated Resource Alert: Legal Momentum Issues Revised Bill of Rights & NYS Toolkit on Workplace Rights for 2024/2025**

Women continue to be undervalued and are regularly subjected to unfair treatment in the workplace. While women too often accept these conditions as inevitable, *it does not have to be this way*. All women -- regardless of economic situation or immigration status -- have certain legal rights, and our laws should seek meaningful workplace equality for all women. Since 2017, Legal Momentum's *Women Valued Initiative* has sought to empower women to achieve this change.

Through the *Initiative*, Legal Momentum has produced comprehensive guidance and tools to advance gender equality in the core issue areas that impact women's economic security. We recently updated two of those resources.

*Informing Women About Their Workplace Rights:* Our updated **Legal Toolkit for Women's Economic Equality** provides comprehensive guidance to women and advocates in New York State on 13 core issues that relate to women's economic equality, including ways to assert those rights. By creating a comprehensive framework for advocacy and assessment, our Bill of Rights seeks to ensure that our laws achieve meaningful and comprehensive workplace equality for all women.
